



Getting The Right Gasket is as easy as **A B C**

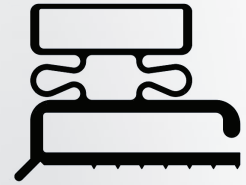


A. Identify the Profile

How does your gasket mount to the door?

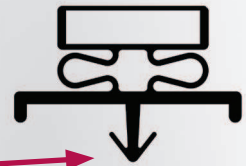
Does it **Screw On?**
(TRG color code: Blue ●)

Has a flap



Is it a **Dart Style?**
(TRG color code: Black ●)

Has a narrow arrow



Does it **Push In?**
(TRG color code: Green ●)

Has a wide wedge

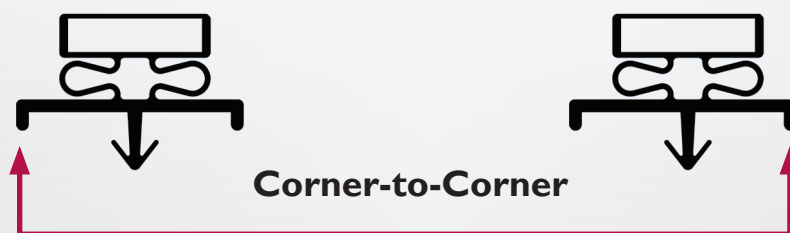


Dart style **Glass Door** gaskets are in a separate group for easy identification.

(TRG color code: Red ●)

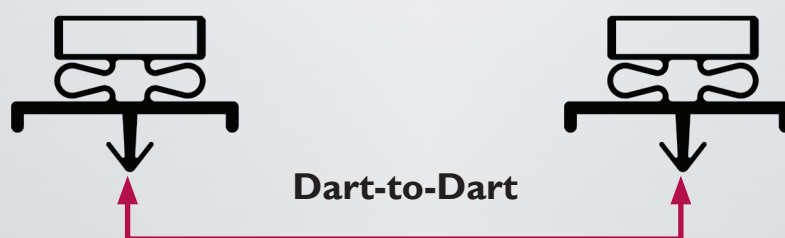
B. Measure your gasket

All gaskets can be measured Corner-to-Corner (Outside Dimensions). Look for “Measure Here” on each profile diagram.



Dart-style and **Push-In** gaskets can also be measured Dart-to-Dart

If a gasket is ill-fitting, in poor condition, or missing, we recommend Dart-to-Dart measurement.



A simple way to be sure of getting an accurate measurement is to measure from the center of the grooves, or from the outside of one side to the inside of the other (see below).



C. Number of Sides

Most **Walk-in** gaskets do not extend across the bottom of the door. Tell us if your gasket has 3 or 4 sides.
